VERMONT FEDERAL CREDIT UNION ELECTS BOARD OF DIRECTOR AT 58th ANNUAL MEETING

Burlington, VT. – On Thursday, April 28, 2011, Vermont Federal Credit Union held its 58th Annual Meeting at the Double Tree Hotel & Conference Center in South Burlington. Re-elected to the Board of Directors was Curran Robinson.

Curran (“Spike”) Robinson retired as 158th Vice Wing Commander, Vermont Air National Guard in 1998, after serving more than 35 years in uniform. A native Vermonter, Spike is a graduate of St. Michael’s College and has been with the Credit Union since 1970. He was elected to the Board in 1985 and has served as our chairman since 1993. He served in the State Legislature from 2003 until 2005 as the representative from Richmond. Spike has represented the Credit Union at many directors’ conferences on both the local and national level. He and his family reside in Richmond.
