VERMONT FEDERAL CREDIT UNION HOLDS BOOK DRIVE TO GATHER BOOKS FOR STUDENT SUMMER READING

Burlington, VT – From May 16th to June 6th, Vermont Federal Credit Union held a book drive in each of their six branch locations. Books were later donated to Soar Learning Center in Saint Albans, and helped to support summer reading.

On Tuesday, June 14th, 2011 Vermont Federal joined students at Soar Learning Center to distribute books gathered from their three week-long book drive. Students grades K -12 initially each selected four books from the four hundred plus books collected. They later returned to select an additional four books from those remaining. These books will allow students to continue to read and work on their reading skills during summer vacation. Extra books will be added to the centers library and individual classrooms libraries. Soar Learning Center currently serves over sixty-four students with emotional, behavioral and learning challenges.
