

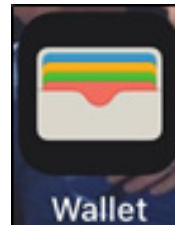
# APPLE PAY GUIDE

Apple Pay works with Apple devices. You can make secure purchases in stores, apps, and on the web. You can send and receive money from friends right in Messages. When you make a purchase, Apple Pay uses a device specific number and unique transaction code. Your card number is never stored on your device, apple servers, or shared with any merchant.

## Step 1

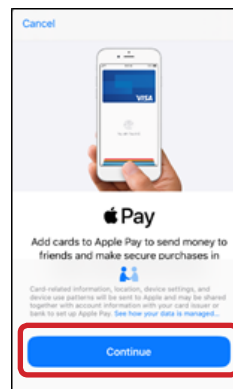
Click on the **Wallet** app.

Then click the “+” sign to add a new card.



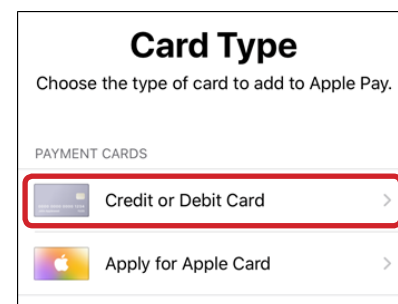
## Step 2



Verify your information is accurate and click **Next**.



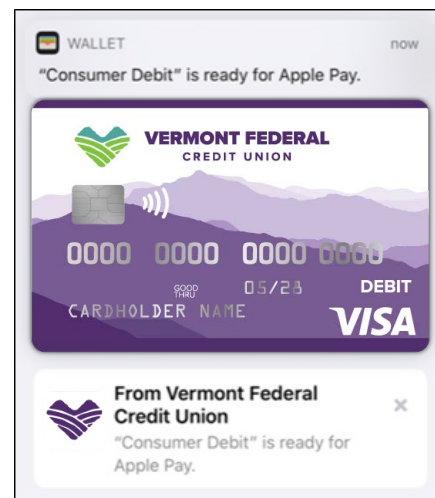
